

Glen Burt, 80, Dies; Rites Set Tuesday

Glen Burt, 80, Estherville, died at noon Sunday at Balmer's Nursing Home. He was born Jan. 26, 1890, at Armstrong to Andrew and Susan Mitchell Burt. He was educated in the Armstrong schools.

On Jan. 10, 1914, he was united in marriage to Gladys Kennedy at Armstrong. After their marriage, they farmed in the Armstrong area. Mrs. Burt died in 1936.

In 1944, Mr. Burt moved to Estherville and worked at the Tobin packing plant until he retired in 1957.
