ARMSTRONG — Services for Mabel Helgason, 92, Armstrong, will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at Nazareth Lutheran Church, Armstrong, with Pastor Paul Rothfusz officiating. Interment will be in Armstrong Grove Cemetery, Armstrong. She died Wednesday, Feb. 3, 1999 at Valley Vue Care Center, Armstrong.

Visitation will be from 4-8 p.m. Friday at Henry-Olson-Fuhrman Funeral Home at Armstrong.

She was born Nov. 7, 1906 at Armstrong, the daughter of Harry and Amy (Moore) Harrison and received her education in the Armstrong schools graduating from high school there in 1925. She attended Iowa Methodist Hospital School of Nursing where she received her degree as a registered nurse in 1928. On June 14, 1929,

she married Oliver Lorenzo Helgason at Fairmont, Minn. Following marriage the couple made their home in the Armstrong area where they lived and farmed most of their married life. She has worked in a hospital and for area doctors: Dr. Bailey, Dr. Roy Turner, Dr. H.A. Lindholm and Dr. C.V. Lindholm. The couple moved into Armstrong in 1974. She has been at Valley Vue Care Center since December, 1998.

She was a member of Nazareth Lutheran Church in Armstrong where she was a deacon; in women's groups; Sunday School teacher and held various offices on the church council. She was a member of various clubs.

Survivors include sons: J. Oliver and Robert Helgason of Armstrong; Harry of Crocker, Mo. and David, Coffeyville, Kansas; 15 grandchil-



dren; 14 great-grandchildren; daughter-in-law, Lois Helgason.
