Kenneth James Huntsinger, the son of James W. and Emma (Schmidt) Huntsinger, was born March 21, 1911 in Watertown, South Dakota and departed this life at his home in Estherville, Iowa on Tuesday, December 24, 1991 at the age of 80 years, 9 months and 3 days.

His family moved to Estherville in 1919. He attended Estherville schools and graduated from Estherville High School in 1930. He was a member of the first Estherville Midgets football team.

On January 28, 1934 he was united in marriage to Mable Moore in Armstrong, Iowa. For twenty six years, until his retirement in 1969, he was a wholesale products salesman for the former Pfaff Baking Company and then Pan-O-Gold Baking Company. Prior to that, he worked in grocery stores owned by the late William Sidles and by the late Clyde Sanborn.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church in Estherville.

Mr. Huntsinger is survived by his wife, Mable of Estherville; two sons: Barry R. Huntsinger of Estherville and James K.
