Dorothy Burt [Lee] Crawford (dau. of John Burt and Sarah Jane Baker)  
sent the following information to someone in Iowa:

Isabell Kirk Burt, was first married to Henry DeWolf. He thought he was a lady's man. He died two weeks before the divorce was final, it cost Isabell \$75. They had one girl – Helen.

She then married James Thomas Bloor not William Blower. Helen was 8 yrs. old then.

I used to go with him (we called him Uncle Jim) and sign his cream checks and he would make an (X) under where I wrote his name. He couldn't read or write.

He had 3 children by his first wife. Mrs. Bloor (Aunt Bella) raised them. When they were grown they moved to Saskatchewan, Canada and bought a big farm.

I have seen the (Bloor) sign over their gate on T.V. My dad visited them 1919. Isabell K. B. Bloor died April 9, 1936, not 1933, I was there. There were only two marriages apiece. I lived with them. James died Sept. 1916 on Lopez Island. He was born Feb. 29 – a leap year baby. (other info does not agree with Feb. 29)

The funeral of Mrs. Bloor's daughter, Ella, was held Monday, Rev. Stevens officiating. Her death occurred a few days after her return from Chicago. Probably no greater sufferer ever secured a happy release in death than she, and all must feel that the end came opportunely. She was a young and attractive woman, and had taken great pains to fit herself for a useful and happy life. She was stricken at the threshold.
