



Cream and Sugar Set

Cream and sugar set that belonged to James and Susan (McFarland) [McFarlane] Mitchell, natives of Scotland who arrived in Canada [Fullarton Twtnshp, Ontario] in June 1861 [1854] and later [1870 to Irvington, then to Armstrong Grove] settled in Armstrong Grove Twp. It is believed that they brought the set with them from Scotland. It was handed down to Lila Beck, then to her daughter, Helen Henriksen.
